In *Smith v Smith* he assisted David Stockill in advancing the applicant's rights to be able to control the winding-up of a family farming partnership following his father's death. He was also junior to Avtar Khangure Q.C. in a multi-million pound breach of fiduciary claim which also involved multiple unfair prejudice allegations. Subsequently he has advised on matters concerning the existence or otherwise of partnerships and regarding dissolutions and windings-up.
